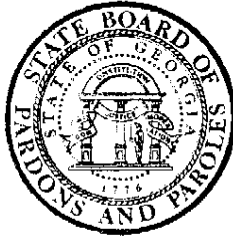


STATE BOARD OF PARDONS AND PAROLES



DENIAL OF COMMUTATION OF SENTENCE OF DEATH

- WHEREAS: Upon the 8th day of February, 2001, a sentence of death was imposed on the defendant in the case of The State of Georgia v. Brian Keith Terrell, 266131, Indictment Number 92-CR-1072; 93-CR-946 through 955, before the Superior Court of Newton County; and,
- WHEREAS: An order of the Superior Court of Newton County, dated the 20th day of November, 2015, directs that Brian Keith Terrell shall be executed by the Department of Corrections during a certain period of time commencing at noon on the 8th day of December, 2015, and ending at noon on the 15th day of December, 2015; and,
- WHEREAS: The State Board of Pardons and Paroles having received, on behalf of Brian Keith Terrell, an application for clemency requesting that the Board exercise its authority to enter orders staying the execution of Brian Keith Terrell, as well as to commute said sentence of death; and,
- WHEREAS: The State Board of Pardons and Paroles has thoroughly and painstakingly reviewed and considered all of the facts and circumstances of the offender and his offense, the clemency application, argument, testimony, and opinion in support of and against clemency;
- THEREFORE: Pursuant to the provisions of Article IV, Section II, Paragraph II (a) and (d) of the Constitution of the State of Georgia, on behalf of the Members of the State Board of Pardons and Paroles, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the clemency application on behalf of Brian Keith Terrell requesting his execution be stayed and that his sentence of death be commuted is **DENIED**.
